I would like to thank Dan Demers for his role in leading the club for the last four years. We have grown and matured in many ways under his leadership. I hope we can keep that growth going.

PMSC is one of Ontario's oldest Motor Sports Clubs, founded in 1953 long before many of our members started playing with toy race cars. We are the longest continuously organizer of rallies in Ontario. We helped found the original Ice Races, I believe on Clear Lake and we had early involvement with Auto Slalom, forerunner to Solo. There are some neat photographs in our scrapbook showing painted oil cans being used as pylons. Yes oil used to come in metal cans. Garages used to drain the drippings from each can once they had a quart it was sold to those who were a little short on cash. That's your History lesson for this Month.

All Presidents enter into the title with plans for change. My plan was distributed as 'New Vision for PMSC'. This Vision sees a new PMSC in the way we communicate internally and with other clubs and the community. We are lucky to have former multiple-term President Len Arminio, take on this role. Len is recently retired from teaching Journalism and Broadcast Journalism at Loyalist College. I cannot think of anyone better for this role.

One major change is a review of our By-Laws along with point structure. When reviewing the By Laws item by item we found numerous incidents that no longer made sense so we are housekeeping these out. Coming up with a point review is a harder challenge. While no problem for individual disciplines it is harder when we try to arrive on how to score a Club Champion. We will continue working on that.

Now it's time for another history lesson.

When the club was created back in '53, members would compete in almost every discipline using the same vehicle, even Ice Racing. Yup... Drive to the lake, (we did lakes back before global warming), tape the lights, attach a number and go racing and drive home afterwards.

Over the years things have changed and many have a different car for each discipline or only compete in one discipline. Personally I think that people miss out when concentrating on a single discipline. We do have several weekend trophies which was a combined Rally-Solo weekend. These have fallen into disuse as we couldn't get enough to participate in the rallies. Many didn't want to take a Solo car down the typical gravel rally roads. This year I would like to see at least one of these weekend trophies be used again. We can create an interesting rally using paved roads and instructions that are suitable for non Rallyists.

February 12-13 is PMSC Ice Race weekend. This weekend is the largest event that PMSC host each year and it needs a lot of help to run smoothly. Available to help and not signed up??
