#### MegaSpeed Debut Impresses By Mark Newell



**The freshly minted "MegaSpeed",** the show formerly known as "Performance Improvement", was held the weekend of March 9-11<sup>th</sup> at the Airport Convention Centre in Toronto.



The event has always been unique in that it brings together multiple automotive disciplines and interests. Seldom can one see street rods, restoration projects, "Rat Rods", motorsports enthusiasts, and the ubiquitous 'import' set in the same venue. The event provided a real cross section of enthusiasts and allows for some interesting cross genre comparisons that just aren't possible anywhere else.

With the change in venue, Friday afternoon attendance seemed lighter than in previous years, but it gave a great

chance to get some photographs, and chat with some of vendors and exhibitors. The quality was high

with many of the previously exhibiting clubs upping their games with some very clever displays.

Compared to previous years and the 'sea of cars' it really stood out and gave the clubs and their cars some needed depth and distinction.

The import scene was well represented, and is starting to show some maturity. Gone are the plethora of body kits and bolt-on money amalgams.



They have been replaced by some examples of clever artistry and attention to detail that is compatible to the street rod sets.

The vendor presence seemed a little more muted this year, with seemingly fewer entries. This could be perhaps due to the change in name and presumably the new management's growing pains. However those that were there were friendly and knowledgeable.



Local drag, dirt trackers, and motorsports parks were all there as well.

I note with some disappointment that there was no presence from the rally community.

But I had a good time and will be back next year.

Welcome and statement from the President.

- Welcome to Tom and Sandy Hyland from BARC. Tom asks if we would be interested in joining with BARC and Oshawa club in a Kart series at Mosport. Runs on weeknights. There is an "Arrive and Drive" class. They supply karts and helmets. Need to wear a proper suit, They rent them too. Tom gives more details. Expressions of interest from some members.
- Earle Bank needs signatures from two "directors". Any of executive are "directors". Earle will pick two.

Since we have increased the worker honorarium to \$50 from \$20, motion to exclude snack bar purchases. Honorarium to be \$25 for workers who are also competing. Carried.

Review ice race financial statement by Earle. We made \$1,760.

Ice Race report – Len. Thanks to 36 workers. Turnout was less than other years, 182 vs 225 last year. No Menard studs, that accounts for 15-18. Len did have "interviews" with a few competitors, about things like running banks, contact etc. Track was terrific. We had 2 days of winter this year and they were on our weekend. Last weekend, they were down to the dirt and had to cancel some races. Len has been organizing the ice races for a while now, anyone else who is interested, please feel free to take over. It's easy. About 1 hour paperwork, mostly soliciting workers.

Website. Has been updated by Evan. Great! Most of our traffic comes from Facebook and forum.

Bulletin was large, 24 pages last edition. Contributions were great.

- Solo Dan. Regional solo. SPDA is sponsoring differently this year rather than one event. They will give \$1,000 to help pay for the venue. Club has to promote them, (some advertising) and the series competitors only have to pay half price. We would stand to make less money this way because our venue costs are so cheap. Dan talked to SPDA about this, they will reimburse us so we don't take a hit because of it.
- GFCR Peter G. Plans are underway. MNR application for extending the road is still in process. Anyone who wants a role, step up.
- 2013 is our 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Peter G. and Len A. willing to lead but not do all the work. Website <u>60thpmsc@on.ca</u>. Some ideas: will have some "historic" cars do laps at the ice races, continue this type of thing throughout the year. At end of year a banquet with memorabilia.

Louis – We have received invitation to 18<sup>th</sup> Canadian Hall of Fame gala. Offers info for anyone interested.


