Ludwig Heimrath (left) and David Deacon (See column to the right) as Co-Grand Marshals for its 2013 Canadian Historic Grand Prix

The VARAC 2013 CHGP is Canada's premier Vintage & Historic racing event. It will be held Father's Day Weekend at the world famous Mosport Grand Prix Circuit, Canadian Tire Motorsport Park near Bowmanville, Ontario.

Del Bruce, President of VARAC said: "I am pleased to confirm that the VARAC 2013 CHGP will feature a tribute to the extremely competitive and ground-breaking Rothman's Porsche 944 Challenge and Turbo Cup Racing Series of the mid to late 1980's. Ludwig Heimrath, known throughout his career as an intense man and one of few words said: "It is an honour to be invited to be Grand Marshal for such an exiting racing series. I am really looking forward to being part of this Vintage Racing Festival."

About Ludwig Heimrath: Ludwig Heimrath won the Canadian Sports Car Racing Championship in 1961 and in 1964. He was first runner-up in '62, '63 and '65. He was only the second Canadian to race in Formula 1 when he entered the U.S. Grand Prix at Watkins Glen in 1963. Later, he won the SCCA Trans-Am championship in 1977. He was an expert long-distance racer, entering the Sebring 12 hours and the 24 Hours of Daytona. He also raced Indy cars and Formula A and his record goes on. In November 2012 he was named an "Honorary Member" of VARAC.

Owen Cule:

Rothwell, Northants, UK

British Rally, Slalom, Track Competitor, and... Former PMSC Member.

Older PMSC members might remember Owen Cule who was a member back in the late 1980s and 1990s. In

1999, Owen headed back to his native England (he was born there and came to Canada as a child with his parents).

He has essentially picked up in the UK where he left off in Canada as far as motorsports are concerned.

Owen stopped by for a visit to the March club meeting, (March 27th) as a guest of one of his former Canadian rally partner, Peter Watt. Owen also paired up with

Greg James and KWRC's Roger Sanderson.

He is still very active in several automotive activities including stage rallies, auto slaloms and track



racing in the UK and is the owner of Cule Motorsport.

Many of you may remember him as a tech at several places in town including Trent Valley Honda.

He hasn't wandered too far away from the tool box either, this time as a teacher. He is a lecturer at Leicester College, about a half-hour drive from his home in Rothwell, Northants. The college, which is a vocational post-secondary institution similar to our community colleges, has a program in Motorsport Engineering. (Check out the link).

According to Owen's own website, "The Motorsport program offers a place where students can gain experience in preparing vehicles for competition as well as standard workshop technician training (Something that isn't usually taught, even in Universities). The course qualification also covers the entry requirements for university engineering programs

In addition students that show an interest can also accompany the team to events and gain essential on-event experience, something that universities and especially employers look for. The vehicles used for the course are privately owned by Owen and include: '85 Honda Civic GT being built to historic circuit racing specification, a VW Polo being built to Rally First (Class) Specifications, Rover 25 rally car and the Rover

Metro GTI rally car that is heavily modified and being used for rallying this year."

Cule Motorsport is also involved in charity work donating time and the Metro in the Wishes 4 Kids charity event. Owen provides rides each year to the children at the Donington Park Race Circuit.

The company team consists two of Owens former students. Edward Thomason is race engineer while working on his degree at Staffordshire University. Ashley Caton is the on-event Crew Chief and oversees the car and any students attending for work experience. He is also using the team to help develop his promotional

film company.



The Co-driver is Emily Stannard, a copyright officer for Reading University. Emily had never sat in a rally car until she teamed up with Owen 7 years ago.

An avid sportswomen Emily also competes in Roller Hockey and Football (aka Soccer) competitions and has a great passion for Formula 1.

Owen's career highlights include:

- 1988 Canadian Honda Michelin Champion (circuit racing)/(crew)
- 1992 Ontario Solo 1 Class Champion (circuit racing)(driver, self-prepared car)
- 1992 IMSA Firestone Firehawk Mosport 24 hour class winner (circuit racing)(crew)
- 1997 Canadian Novice Rally Champion (driver, self-prepared car)
- 1998 Ontario Production 1750 Rally Champion (driver, self-prepared car)
- 1998 TMI Racing (Pro team...Complete bare chassis rebuild of a SCCA Trans-AM race car for the 1998 race season)
- Canada- Many other wins in the different disciplines both at Club and national levels

2000-present

- 3 time class winner at the Rockingham Stages Rally
- Class wins at hill climbing and sprinting
- Competed in various events and disciplines around the country
- Plans to enter the "Club Stage" event at a WRC event this fall.

Points have been calculated for Ice Racing.


Communications Director - Len Arminio: An ice race organizers meeting will be arranged to discuss entry fees and the distribution of funds. Date and time to be determined.
